 Please review this information prior to coming to the hospital. If you need lab work done before your procedure, please have it done several days before your procedure. Bring your written order. You must have someone drive you home and stay with you overnight after your procedure, unless you are admitted to the hospital. Do not eat or drink anything except for sips of water with your medication(s) after midnight the night before your procedure. Please bring all your medications to the hospital the day of your procedure. They be sent home with you. You will not be permitted to take medications brought in from home while you are in the hospital. 	er 12 will

WHAT TO EXPECT: A specially trained doctor, called a vascular surgeon, will perform your procedure. Your vascular surgeon or their staff will explain your procedure.

WHAT TO BRING TO THE HOSPITAL:

• This packet of information

- A copy of your living will or durable power of attorney for health care (advance directives) if you have one.
- Any toiletry items you would like.
- Bring all your current medications. **You will not be permitted** to take your home medications while in the hospital, but the nurses need the names(s) and dosage(s) of each medication.
- Please <u>do not bring valuables</u> to the hospital such as purse, wallet, jewelry, money, credit cards, etc. Bring only your ID and insurance cards.

QUESTIONS PRIOR TO YOUR PROCEDURE:

Call your doctor office for any questions about your procedure.

SCHEDULING AND REGISTRATION: Pre-registration is required for an accurate medical record and proper billing. You may be contacted by a patient access representative if we need any information. If you have questions or need to reschedule your surgery, please call the doctor who will be doing your procedure.

HOSPITAL PARKING

Free visitor parking is available in Lot 3 across from the Bedford building. Enter from 6th Street. Valet parking is available at the 7th Street and Bedford building entrances for a fee – or free if you are a handicapped motorist. Deck parking is available on 7th Street for a fee based on your length of stay.

DIRECTIONS TO THE DEPARTMENT: The Heart and Vascular Center (Lot 3 parking is the closest parking) is located on the first floor of the Bedford building. After entering the Bedford lobby, turn to your right and enter the Heart and Vascular Center. Please sign in on the kiosk (iPad) by typing in your name and have a seat on the left side of the waiting room until you are called.
